

# Drug search tool

Finding Rx information is easy

Geisinger Health Plan's (GHP)\* drug search tool, PilotRx, can help you determine if your prescriptions are covered and how much they will cost. It also allows you to compare pricing at different pharmacies in your area. To access PilotRx, please go to thehealthplan.com. For more detailed information, log in as a member. 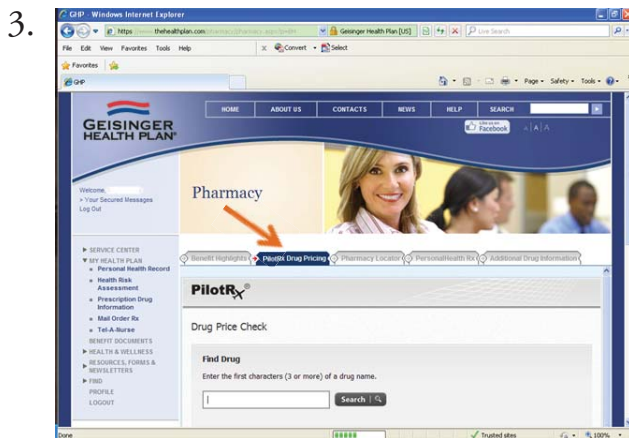
To view covered drugs, drug costs and detailed information (Recommended):



Go to thehealthplan.com and sign in as a member in the upper left hand corner. If you don't have a member ID, click "Register" to create one.



Click on "Prescription Drug Information" under "My Health Plan" on the left side of the screen.



On the pharmacy screen, click on the "PilotRx Drug Pricing" tab to enter a prescription name and begin the price check process. *Note: Pricing includes deductible amount until your deductible is paid in full.*

- Be sure to take advantage of other tools offered in GHP's pharmacy section:
- Benefit highlights - Provides information regarding your benefit plan, deductibles, and copayments.
  - Pharmacy locator - Find a pharmacy near you and get directions.
  - PersonalHealth Rx - View and print your current drug history and yearly tax reports of drug expenditures.
  - Additional drug information - Find information on more than 17,000 medications.

To view covered drugs, excluding drug costs:

1. Go to thehealthplan.com.
2. On the left side under "Find," click on "Covered Drugs."
3. Click on the appropriate drug category based on your benefit plan.
4. Click on "Printable Formulary" to print a list of prescriptions or click on "Search Covered Drugs" to enter a prescription name. *Note: Pricing information is not available unless you log in as a registered member.*
